Marathi compulsory in Maha, learning other languages a choice: CM Fadnavis

If someone opposes Marathi, then it won't be tolerated, says CM

AFTER THE MAHARASHTRA government made Hindi compulsory as a third language under NEP 2020, chief minister Devendra Fadnavis on Saturday asserted that while Marathi is non-negotiable and must be learned by all, learning additional languages remains a personal choice. Speaking to the media, Fadnavis, expressing surprise at the opposition to Hindi and the growing preference for English, warned that any challenge to Marathi will not be tolerated.

"Marathi language is compulsory in Maharashtra; everyone should learn it. Additionally, if you wish to learn other languages, you can do so. Opposition to Hindi and promotion of English is surprising. If someone opposes Marathi, then it will not be tolerated," CM Fadnavis said. Earlier today, Congress leader

opposed the decision, asking the government not to "impose" the language. Speaking to ANI, Wadettiwar, emphasising that Marathi is the mother tongue, warned against any coercion that undermines the rights of Marathi-speaking people.

"You can keep it optional, but you cannot impose it. At whose behest are you trying to impose this language on the state?" the Congress leader asked."We consider Marathi our mother tongue, and this third language that is being introduced should not be brought in. There should be no coercion against the rights of the Marathi people -- this is our demand,"Wadettiwar said.

In line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the Maharashtra government has made the teaching of Hindi compulsory as a third language from Class 1 in all state board schools, alongside Marathi and English.

Rahul Ashok Rekhawar, director of the State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Maharashtra, said on Thursday that the decision was taken by the School Education Department on April 16.

"On behalf of the Maharashtra Government, the School Education Department has taken a decision in which teaching Hindi language along with Marathi and English has been made com-

pulsory from class 1 in all the schools of the state board. This decision has been made with all the appointments and their development in view, and the students will definitely benefit from it," Rekhawar told ANI. He clarified that the move is

solely for educational purposes and not driven by any political or community agenda. NCP (SP) leader Supriya Sule on Saturday said that undermining Marathi in the forceful implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 in Maharashtra would not be tolerated. Sule's statement comes amid the opposition's outcry over the Maharashtra government's decision to make Hindi a mandatory third language for students of Classes 1 to 5 in Marathi and Englishmedium schools across the state, in a departure from the practice of studying two languages.

The Baramati MP said, "I was first to oppose the education minister's statement about making the CBSE board compulsory in Maharashtra.

What is the need to replace the existing state board with CBSE? Before discussing the language issue, we must talk about the basic education infrastructure in the state."

Won't allow compulsion of Hindi: **Uddhav**

SHIV SENA (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray on Saturday asserted that his partywill not allow making Hindi compulsory in Maharashtra after the state government decided to make Hindi a mandatory third language for students of classes 1 to 5. Addressing an event of the Bharatiya Kamgar Sena, the workers' wing of the Shiv Sena (UBT), Thackeray said his party has no aversion to the Hindi language but asked why it is being forced.

Thackeray claimed it is the ruling BJP's mission not to let people unite and to keep them under constant pressure so that they are occupied with their worries. "We will not allow making Hindi compulsory in Maharashtra," he said.

LOGISTIC FIRM DELHIVERY and Ecom Express have sought Competition Commission of India's (CCI) approval for their ₹1,400-crore deal. Under the deal announced on April 5, Delhivery will acquire a controlling stake in Ecom Express for a cash consideration of ₹1,400 crore.

While Delhivery is a listed integrated logistics player, Ecom Express provides logistics solutions to the Indian ecommerce industry. According to the notice submitted to the regulator, the relevant products and geographic markets can be left open, given that the proposed deal will not lead to any change in the competitive dynamics, let alone cause any appreciable adverse effect on competition, in any market in India. provision of express parcel delivery services in India, and for provision of warehousing and supply chain services in India can be considered as relevant ones.

In terms of vertical relationships, the relevant markets for provision of intralogistics automation services in India (at the upstream level), and for provision of logistics services in India (at the downstream level) can be considered, as per the notice.

Further, the notice said the proposed transaction reflects the Indian economy's continuous requirement for improvements in cost efficiency, speed and reach of logistics.

"The proposed transaction will enable the parties to service their customers better, through continued investments in infrastructure, technology, network and people," it added.

Tesla to delay launch of affordable EV 'Model Y' in the US



Tesla also planning to launch bare-bones version of Model 3 compact sedan

TESLA'S LONG-AWAITED plans for an affordable car include a US-made, strippeddown version of its best-selling electric SUV, the Model Y, but the production launch has been delayed, three sources with knowledge of the matter told Reuters.

Tesla has promised affordable vehicles beginning in the first half of the year, providing a potential boost to flagging sales. Global production of the lowercost Model Y, internally codenamed E41, is expected to begin in the United States, the sources said. That would occur at least a few months later than outlined in Tesla's public plan, they added, offering a range of revised targets from the third quarter to early next year.

The reason for the delay was not clear. Two of the people said Tesla aimed to produce 250,000 of the cheaper Model Ys in the United States in 2026. The new

vehicle is also planned for eventual production in China and Europe, *Reuters* has previously reported. The delay of US production and the US production target have not been previously reported. Tesla reports results on Tuesday, and plans for the new vehicles are a major question. The less expensive mass-

market vehicles have been widely anticipated by Tesla fans and investors who hope they will attract a fresh group of customers and reverse the EV maker's falling sales and eroding market share. Tesla also has refreshed its original Model Y with exterior and interior changes. The Long Range All-Wheel Drive version in the United States costs about \$49,000, before a \$7,500 federal tax credit.

Reuters reported last month that the China launch of the E41 will occur in 2026. The E41 will be smaller and cost 20% less to produce than the refreshed Model Y, the sources familiar with China plans told Reuters. The timing of the rollout in Europe is not clear.—**REUTERS**

Mumbai airport will remain shut for 6 hours on May 8

FLIGHT OPERATIONS AT the city's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport (CSMIA) will remain shut for six hours on May 8, due to runway maintenance work ahead of the onset of the monsoon season, the private airport operator MIAL said on Saturday.

The Mumbai International Airport Ltd (MIAL) also said that the mandatory NOTAM (Notice to Airmen) was issued six months in advance to notify all stakeholders, enabling airlines to adjust their flight schedules well ahead of time and plan

accordingly. The scheduled pre-monsoon maintenance work on both the runways- 09/27 and 14/32-will be undertaken between 11

am-17 pm, MIAL said. During this period both the primary runway (09/27) and secondary runway (14/32) will be temporarily non-operational, it said. This annual pre-monsoon maintenance is crucial for preserving the health and longevity of the airport airside infrastructure, it added.
